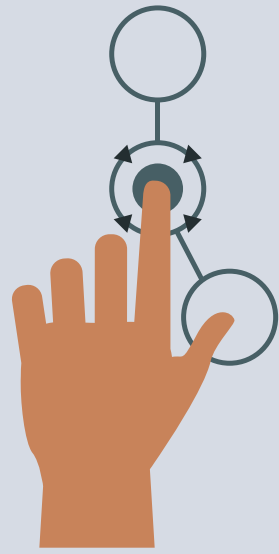


SHOWING GUIDE DURING COVID-19 REOPENING

As restrictions begin to ease in our state, we are implementing safe practices for home showings.

Virtual Tours

Narrow your home search through virtual tours, videos and other technology to reduce in-person showings.



Practice Social Distancing



Remain 6 feet apart, avoid shaking hands.

Pre-qual Letters Required for Showings

Serious and qualified buyers only.



No Overlapping Appointments

Showings will be restricted to one appointment at a time. Please do not bring children or other family members.



Disclose COVID-19 Symptoms

Anyone exhibiting signs or symptoms must reschedule their showing.



COVID-19 Sensitive Etiquette

Wear a mask at all times. Do not touch light switches, cabinets, door handles, or any other touch points in the home. Comply with all seller requests during showing.

Sellers will wipe down and disinfect all surfaces and touch points including key, lock box, and other surfaces.

Buyers should use hand sanitizer when they leave and use the disinfectant wipes as well.

Agents should speak to their clients over the phone or outside of the property where they can remain 6 feet apart.

Remove Shoes, Wear Booties, Wash Hands

Remove shoes AND wear booties. Wash your hands or use hand sanitizer, and wear gloves.
